
And thanks to our HQ team members who traded longer hours just to be a part of this adventure.

locations-hinting at potential growth.)



(The dot scales down to the period and reveals the message 'definitely doing something.')




VO: So on this..

(Our view pans out and the message turns counter-clockwise.)



BETTER.


VO: ...better. ('Better' slides into place and becomes orange.)
